Matignon High School was founded in 1947 by Richard Cardinal Cushing, the Archbishop of Boston, and was the first Central Catholic High School in the Boston area. It opened a new chapter in its history in December 2005, when it was endorsed by the Jesuits, entering an exciting partnership with one of the oldest religious organizations in the world.

Ninety-five percent of Matignon seniors are accepted by the college of their choice. Matignon graduates currently attend Amherst, Harvard, Holy Cross, the University of Chicago, MIT, Tufts, Wellesley, Williams and many other fine schools.
