## ATTENDANCE

The intensive work of the program makes it imperative that students be in regular attendance. Excessive absences will jeopardize a student's chance to receive passing grades. Therefore, absences shall not exceed one class meeting. Accumulated tardy time will also count toward absences. This is necessary to meet accreditation standards.

## CREDITS

High school students who are recommended by their principal or guidance counselor will have their marks credited to their permanent school record only if class attendance and course requirements are met by the student.

Students who are seeking credit for courses taken in Summer School must have prior approval in writing from their school principal.

Upon satisfactory completion of summer study a transcript of the student's record will be sent to the office of the school in which the student is enrolled.

## MARKING SYSTEM

Progress reports will be mailed home halfway through the course. A final evaluation will be mailed home within two weeks of the final class meeting.

## LOCATION AND TRANSPORTATION

Matignon High School is located in North Cambridge near the Arlington and Somerville lines, just minutes from Rte. 2/Alewife intersection and from Rte. 93. There is easy access from all major MBTA routes. From the western suburbs of Boston, the commuter rail to Porter Square, Cambridge is also available.
